Academic Information

Coding and Numbering of courses:

All degree programmes have alphanumeric codes (e.g. POLI 445).

The four letters stand for a department or subject (e.g. POLI for Political Science). The letters are followed by a 3-digit number which denotes the year of study. Digits are in the following range:

• Level 100 (First Year) Courses: 100-199 (not recommended for visiting students)

Level 200 (Second Year) Courses: 200-299 (Recommended)
 Level 300 (Third Year) Courses: 300-399 (Recommended)
 Level 400 (Fourth Year) Course: 400-499 (Recommended)

The third digit in the number code further denotes when a course is taught during the academic year:

- Zero (0) denotes a course that is offered over both semesters.
- An odd number (1, 3, 5, 7, or 9) denotes a course offered in the fall semester (e.g. SOCI 305).
- An Even number (2,4,6,8) denotes a course offered in the spring semester (e.g. INFS 206)

Credit

Three (3) course credit is defined as

- Two hours of lecture per week
- One-hour tutorial per week or
- Two hours of practical sessions per week

One (1) course credit is defined as

- One-hour lecture per week or
- One-hour tutorial per week or
- Two hours of practical sessions per week

** Visiting undergraduate students are only allowed to take courses at levels 200 to 400

Number of Credits/ Courses per semester

Minimum: 15 credits (5 undergraduate courses- i.e. 3 credit hours each)

Maximum: 18 credits (6 undergraduate courses i.e. 3 credit hours each)
