Foundation English Programme (FEP)

FEP is a unique pre-entry intensive English learning programme for a seamless degree study at UG, one of Africa's prestigious universities.

Structure of FEP

- **English Proficiency Self-Assessment.**
Applicants to a degree programme to self-assess their English proficiency on the application portal as either
 - Pre-intermediate or
 - Intermediate.
- **Diagnostic Test**
 - Self-Assessed pre-intermediate students, no diagnostic test. Optional 8-weeks Basic English Programme (BEP)
 - Self-Assessed intermediate students, diagnostic test by the third or fourth week of June.
- **Placements**
 - Pre-intermediate students' study 1-year Certificate in English Proficiency programme (CEPP)
 - Intermediate students' study 8-weeks pre-enrolment Academic English programme (AEP)
- **Progression**
 - Pre-intermediate students shall proceed to their admitted degree programmes the next academic year upon passing of final exams on the CEPP.
 - Intermediate students shall proceed to their admitted degree programmes in the current academic year upon passing of final exams on the AEP.

NB: Students who fail the final exams on either CEPP or AEP must repeat the exams.



APPLICATION

UG offers **rolling admissions** with **no application deadline** for undergraduate degree programmes. Application to a degree programme and FEP is the same for all non-Anglophone students. To apply for a degree programme, you must:

- Have high school results [French Baccalaureate, WASSCE, A-Levels + O-Levels, IB, etc]
- Complete and submit an online application at <https://apply.ug.edu.gh/admissions/iundergrad/login>
- Be ready to take a diagnostic test at UG Language Centre if your English Proficiency self-assessment is at the intermediate level.

FEES

- Application processing fee - US\$110.00
- Pre-intermediate one-year CEPP US\$1,753.00
- Intermediate 8-weeks AEP - US\$ 400.00
- Optional 8-weeks BEP - US\$ 250.00
